Note:

In order to take only 12 graduate hours before the fifth year, students will take PHI 4134 if taking PHI 5555/5665 as a junior, or PHI 5135 if taking no other graduate course as a junior.

Program admission requirements:

- 1) Students should have taken at least three philosophy courses and should apply for admission by the beginning of the junior year.
- 2) Students should have a GPA of at least 3.3 in philosophy courses.
- 3) Students should have an overall GPA of at least 3.0.

List of courses that may be double-counted:

PHH 5105, PHH 5405, PHH 5505, PHH 5609, PHI 5135, PHI 5136, PHI 5555, PHI 5665.

Differences from BA program:

- 1) Students are not required to take PHI 4938 (Seminar for Majors) since they will be taking graduate seminars.
- 2) Students must pass both PHI 3300 and PHI 4500 with a grade of B or better (rather than just one M&E course) in order to take PHI 5555 in the spring of the junior year.
- 3) Students must pass PHI 3670 with a grade of B or better in order to take PHI 5665 in the spring of the junior year.
