## Paper

- *Prepared for anonymous review*
- *No more than 4,000 words*
- *Suitable for 25-minute presentation*

## Cover Page

- *Presenter's name*
- *Institutional affiliation*
- *Contact information*
- *Title of paper*
- *150-250 word abstract*
- *Word count*

**The deadline for submissions is August 31, 2024.** We will notify those whose papers have been accepted no later than September 23, 2024.
